Stock Class Rules 2023

**Will require a mandatory transponder. You can buy them online or we have them available as well at Crown Motors in Wasilla at 201 w. Parks hwy.

PASSENGERS IN ALL CLASSES INCLUDING DEMO IS NOT PERMITTED

Vehicle Type and Wheelbase

- Vehicle is required to be a full or mid size American made car or truck.
- Vehicle is required to have a stock wheelbase of 101" wheelbase +/- 1".
- Vehicles are required to be rear wheel drive only.

Safety Equipment

- Fire Suit is **mandatory** for all vehicle occupants.
- All race vehicles are required to have fire extinguishers mounted within drivers reach when strapped into the vehicle.
- 5 Point restraint harness is recommended, at minimum 4 point harness or racing style restraints are required.
 - Harnesses are required to be securely mounted.
- All race vehicles require a driver's window net.
 - PASSENGERS ARE NOT PERMITTED
- Drive shafts are required to be painted white or bright color and have a safety loop.
- Batteries are required to be securely mounted and covered.
- All switches are required to be securely mounted and labeled.
- All race vehicles are required have functioning brakes
- Drivers and passengers are required to wear a helmet with eye protection.

Roll Cage Requirements

- 4 Point full width cage minimum is required. Roll cage is also required to be mounted to the frame.
- Minimum tubing size is 1.25 inch ID schedule 40 pipe.
- The Driver's side is required to have a minimum of 3 horizontal bars, and two horizontal bars on the passenger side.
 - If a vehicle is equipped with a passenger seat, the passenger side is required

to have a minimum of 3 horizontal bars.

- The drivers main loop is required to be over their head, and required above passengers head **if** equipped.
- If the roll cage is mounted to unibody, frame mounting plates must be utilized. Self tapping bolts or screws are <u>not permitted</u>.

Body

- All glass and plastic is required to be removed.
- May radius fenders for clearance. Sharp edges are <u>not permitted</u>.
- Body is required to be stock sheet metal, or aluminum.
- Aftermarket body panels are <u>not permitted</u> in a stock apparel event
- Reflective devices and mirrors are <u>not permitted</u>.
- Bodies may be stripped of inner metal.
- Homemade noses are permitted. Wings are <u>not permitted</u>.
- Spoilers no taller than stock are <u>not permitted</u>.
- Firewall is required to stay in stock location.
- Side bars no bigger than 1.25 Inch ID are permitted with a maximum of 1 inch away from body, must be smooth radius and terminate at least 3 inches into body with no sharp edges.
- Headers are permitted to go outside of the fenders.

Bumpers

- Bumpers are required to be stock or homemade using an acceptable race car design with full nose piece cover.
 - Aftermarket bumpers are permitted for front and rear.
- Bumpers are required to be securely attached, and may be reinforced with black iron pipe
- Reinforcements are required to be a smooth radius that terminates at least 3 inches inside the body.
- Nerf bars are allowed. Smooth edges are required.
 - Discretion is up to the tech official.

Frame

- Frame is required to be of parent manufacturer.
- Attachment points for wreckers are required to be present at both the front and rear of the vehicle.

Front End Suspension

- **Required** to remain stock in appearance, and components are also required to remain in stock location.
- Alterations to the front end except for aftermarket upper A arms are <u>not</u> <u>permitted</u>.
- Weight jacks are permitted, as well as the use of an adjustable sway bar.

• Reinforcing is permitted and not considered a modification.

Differential- Rear End Suspension

- Stock Differential only, not limited to parent manufacturer.
- Stabilizer bar from top of differential to frame is permitted.
- Alterations aside from reinforcing are not permitted.
- Shocks are required to stay stock and in stock location.

Engine

- Engines are required to be of parent manufacturer.
- Engines are required to have battery operated ignition.
- 200 LBS maximum compression permitted.
- Engines are required to have a stock cast iron block. Cast Iron LS Engine permitted.
- OE aluminum heads or OE replacement aluminum heads permitted.
- Use of superchargers, non OEM electronic fuel injection and turbo chargers is <u>not permitted</u>.
- Single naturally aspirated carburetor, as well as OEM electronic fuel injection is permitted.
- Engines are required to remain in stock location, no set back allowed.
- Non OEM block's are permitted.
- Light weight and aluminum blocks are not permitted.
- Use of roller cams permitted.

Transmission

- Stock automatic transmission with torque convertor or standard transmission with clutch and pressure plate is permitted.
- Functioning forward and reverse gears are required.
- Required to be self starting out of gear, and required to be able to shift into gear while running.

Fuel- Fuel tanks

- Gasoline only.
- Fuel cell use is recommended.
- Fuel cell is required to be securely mounted in the trunk area and have a spill check valve.
- All vehicles require a firewall between driver and fuel tank.

Tires and Rims

- Snow, or studded tires are <u>not permitted</u>.
- Tires must not have tread wide than 8 Inches

- 10 Inch maximum width rims permitted.
- Beadlocks permitted.
- Tire grooving permitted.

Numbers

- All race vehicles are required to have numbers on both sides of the vehicle, and on the roof.
- Numbers must be legible from the timing tower and of contrasting color to paint scheme.

Weight

- Vehicles are required to be a minimum of 2800 LBS coming off the track with the driver.
- Any weights added to the vehicle are required to be securely mounted and clearly marked with the vehicle's number.
